Monday 24th **St. Sharbel Makholf** became a monk at the monastery of St. Maron at Annaya and was ordained in 1859 until his death in 1898. He became a hermit from 1875. He was much sought after for counsel and blessing and had a great personal devotion and blessing to the Blessed Sacrament.

St Declan is considered to be one of the pre-Patrician saints. He was of noble blood. Colman a local priest, baptised him. Later he went to Europe to continue his studies where he was ordained priest and possibly bishop. He settled in Ardmore and evangelised the Decies country.

Tuesday 25th**St. James, Apostle,** son of Zebedee and brother of John, called the Greater. He was put to death by Herod Agrippa about the year 44, being the Apostles to die for Christ. His shrine is at Compostella in Spain.

Wednesday 26th **Ss. Joachim and Anne**. Traditionally named parents of the Virgin Mary and grandparents of the Lord.

Saturday 29th Ss. Martha Mary and Lazarus
