CALENDAR.

Monday 1st:-**All Saints**:-"The ultimate object of veneration of the Saints is the glory of God and the Sanctification of man by conforming one's life fully to the Divine Will and by imitating the virtue of those who were pre-eminent disciples of the Lord.

Tuesday 2nd:-**All Souls** (The Commemoration of The Faithful Departed)

Wednesday 3rd:-**St Malachy** was born near Armagh in 1094. He introduced the Cistercians and the Canons Regular into Ireland. He died at Clairvaux in 1148

Thursday 4th:-**St Charles Borromeo**, 1538-'84 Cardinal Archbishop of Milan at the age of twenty one, worked for reform in his diocese, drafting the Catechism of the Council of Trent. Patron Saint of catechists and seminarians.

Friday 5th:-**St. Martin de Porres**:-1579-1639, became a Dominican lay brother, spending his nights in prayer and penance, his days in the monastery caring for the sick and the poor. He is renowned for his devotion for his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.

Saturday 6th:-**All Saints of Ireland** ' In the communion of Saints, many and varied spiritualities have been developed throughout the history of the Churches...The different schools of Christian spirituality share in the living tradition of prayer and are essential guides for the faithful. In their rich diversity they are refractions of the One Pure Light of The Holy Spirit.
